



Our Grounds

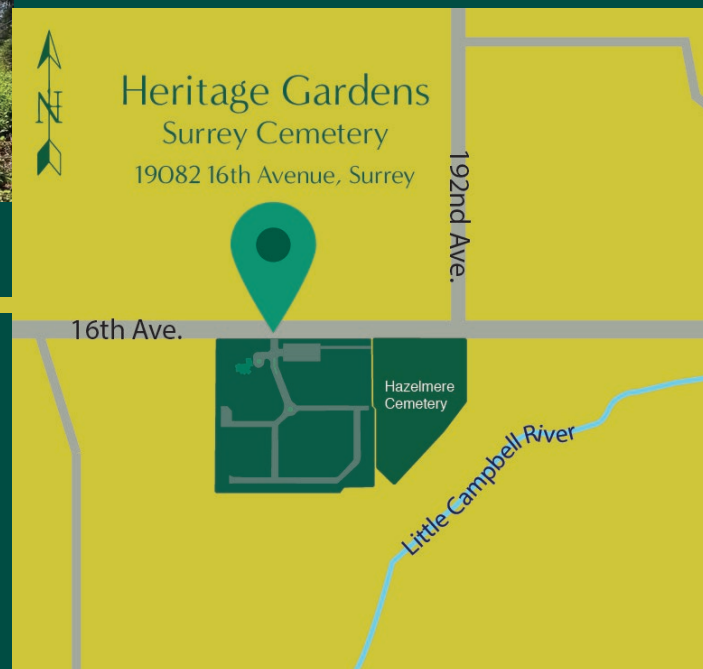
Situated in the Campbell Valley Region of South Surrey, we are surrounded by towering Cedars and Douglas Firs. Within our grounds you will find the **Greater Vancouver Orthodox Cemetery** and **Sampaguita Garden**, two of our community partners. Adjacent is the **Magnolia Garden**, offering memorial tree burials.

The South East corner is home to our **Green Burial Garden**, offering an eco-friendly alternative to traditional burial. Nearby is our pollinator meadow, where tall grasses, wildflowers, and other native flowering plants provide a welcome source of food—and work—for two resident bee hives. The result is a beautiful place of memory, buzzing with life.



Behind our property runs the Little Campbell River. We have dedicated over two acres of the grounds back to the City and converted them into a protected natural conservation area, where deer and other wildlife are often spotted. Come visit us to see this beautiful and unique place for yourself.

Immediate Need
